Soho Warehouse, straddling the border of Downtown and Boyle Heights (also known as the Arts District). The members' club-hospitality conglomerate's third SoCal assay is housed in an early-20th-century building, boasting the requisite rooms, restaurant and rooftop pool (along with an ambitious half-dozen bars). *From \$195; sohowarehouse.com.*

To the west, designer **Kelly Wearstler's** second Proper Hotel in Santa Monica offers 271 rooms and suites in a landmark 1920s Spanish colonial revival building, a restaurant collaboration between local cult table Sqirl and Mexico City's Contramar, and a sprawling Ayurvedic spa. *From \$450; properhotel.com.*
